



Foam Concentrate Test Report - What is required

Foam Concentrate Test Report

The purpose of a Foam Concentrate Test Report is to evaluate if the sample tested is in satisfactory condition and most importantly, is within the manufacturer's specification

Samples required:

Please provide at least 1 litre of foam concentrate. Samples should ideally be provided in clean tightly sealed bottles and be labelled with the following information,

- Type of foam concentrate, eg 6% AFFF
- Name of company
- Date of sample taken
- Sample location point

How do I take a sample of Foam Concentrate.

The foam concentrate sample should be representative of the stored product. The three recognised sample procedures most frequently used are,

- Single sample - Circulate the stored product to obtain a single homogeneous sample.
- Two samples - Take a sample from the top and bottom of the stored product and composite the samples into a single unit.
- Three samples - Take a top, middle and bottom sample and composite into a single unit.
