The BIT-1000 trailer is highly effective when filled with FP70 Plus or Alcoseal for base injection applications on hydrocarbon storage tanks. It can be fitted with two High Back Pressure Generators, two portable inductors ready plumbed for fast and troublefree operation and up to 16 lengths of Duraline layflat fire hose.
